- 7. Have you been trained in any spa treatment protocols? Which ones?
- 8. Have you had training in working in prenatal massage? If yes, how many hours of training did you receive?
- 9. Have you had training in working with clients who have or have had cancer? If yes, how many hours of training did you receive?
- 10. How many clients do you typically see in a day?
- 11. Is that the number you'd like to be seeing?
- 12. How long do you work on each person?
